God Cares School was founded by Pastor Bethuel and Florence Dongo in 2002, who created the NGO (non-profit) called Buyamba Orphan Outreach in Uganda. This non-profit is still the current oversite of GCS. It is still run by the Dongo family and interfaces with the non-profit here in the U.S. that we lovingly refer to as Buyamba Uganda. As most of our supporters know, Buyamba means "help." **Our mission is to offer love, hope and a future, through education and discipleship...one child at a time.** That means we reach out to many families and children that God leads us to work with, and the students' profiles are very diverse.



At God Cares School, we have students with different backgrounds and nationalities. On God Cares playground on any morning, one would see Ugandan children and children from Kenya, Sudan, Tanzania, Ethiopia, Congo, and Rwanda. Although the school is based on a Biblical worldview teaching and discipleship program, we have seen children from many Muslim families over the years and other diverse beliefs such as witchcraft. We believe that "God Cares" about them all, and His hand is mighty to save His little ones. Thousands of children over the years have spent much of their childhood at God Cares School, whether their entry was in the baby class (3 years old) or somewhere in the primary school or the high school. Hundreds of children over the years have also gone into trade school or university, and our Buyamba program is committed to seeing them through.

Our vision is to empower these students to impact their nation for Christ. The following are two student stories that represent elements of many of the children at GCS.

My name is Joanet, and I am in my 3rd year at Africa Renewal University, majoring in child development. My father and mother separated when I was still a toddler (5 months old), and I have lived with my single mother since then.



My mother is the breadwinner at home, for my father does not provide anything for us as a family. My mother is a tailor, and she does not earn enough to provide for all our basic needs. Before joining Buyamba, my mother always struggled to keep me in school, and most times, I was always at home because of school fees. When I joined Buyamba in 2014, all things turned around. I am now able to be in school, and my mother can meet our basic home needs. I no longer have to worry about my father contributing to my education.

Through our school chapel, I have learned that God loves me, and He has a big plan for me. I am so happy that I will be sitting for my National Primary Leaving Exams this year.
