

SPONSORSHIP GUIDE

Learn to do good...Seek Justice... Defend the Orphan...Isaiah 1:17





WHY DO THESE CHILDREN NEED TO BE SPONSORED?

There are over 2.5 million orphans in Uganda, due largely to AIDS, and diseases such as malaria, dehydration, respiratory infections and even simple viruses.

One out of six children walking the streets are orphaned by at least one parent. Education and discipleship are the hope to produce thriving citizens and leaders who will impact Uganda for Christ. For just \$35 a month, you can change a life forever.

WHAT DOES SPONSORSHIP PAY FOR?

Your donation supports your child's needs. An Educational Sponsorship pays for needs such as tuition, uniform, school supplies, health checks and food each day. A Residential Sponsorship is needed only for those children who board at the school and covers a child's living expenses such as food, room and board.

HOW LONG CAN I SPONSOR MY CHILD?

Sponsorship is a journey with your particular child for the school duration. This bond can last through high school and beyond. Our goal is to launch a graduate into a successful next step, whether that is trade school, college or a job situation. Your child will benefit greatly from encouragement, prayer, and your financial support.

CAN I COMMUNICATE WITH MY CHILD?

Yes! Buyamba encourages both the sponsor and the child to have a relationship! The Uganda office will send letters and report cards from the student to you through the U.S. office. You can also write a letter directly to Uganda or through our website at www.buyambauganda. com. Please note the child's information such as full name and ID#. Do not include your own address, phone number or email, as all communications from your child will be sent through the U.S. office. Please do not write to your child on Facebook due to the Internet cost on the Uganda side.

CAN I DO ANYTHING EXTRA FOR MY CHILD?

Pray! These children need your prayers. Your sponsorship is a gift and is all they need to attend God Cares School. In order to emphasize the value of school within the Ugandan



culture, God Cares School expects your child's family to contribute a small amount towards school requirements. Students are instructed not to ask for any additional items from their sponsors so please do not ask them what they "need."

If you decide you would like to give an extra gift for your child at anytime, you may do a onetime gift through the Buyamba office (\$25-\$50) and the social worker on the Uganda side will meet with your child, determine their need and purchase a gift that will make an impact. We will send you a photo of your child with the gift they received. Sending packages directly to Uganda is discouraged due to very high postage and postal fees on the Uganda side that the ministry is called on to pay.

IS IT POSSIBLE TO MEET MY CHILD?

Yes, Buyamba offers sponsors the opportunity to join one of our short-term mission trips that are scheduled twice a year and are open to sponsors and donors through an application process. Please contact the office for details at ugandabuyamba@ gmail.com.

WHAT KIND OF COMMUNICATION CAN I EXPECT FROM THE BUYAMBA OFFICE?

Buyamba will send you monthly newsletters, which may contain a letter from your child, a report card, annual photo, or your donation record for tax purposes. We rely on our Uganda office for any updates on your child. You will receive a call if there are any changes with eligibility, or if we have any donation or billing questions. Please note that some communications from Uganda may take months due to its dependency on teams coming and going to Uganda.
